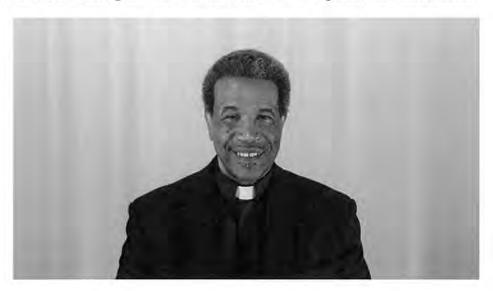

1. Secretary to the Board

The Chairperson of the Board appoints a non-member of the Board to serve as Secretary to the Board. This individual is designated to attend all Board of Trustees meetings, notify or cause proper notification to be given to all members of the Board of all Board meetings, record or cause the recording of accurate minutes of all Board meetings and cause a copy of all minutes to be transmitted to each Board member before each ensuing meeting, properly maintain and store all records and statements as required by law, and serve as the local election official in order to fulfill all election-related duties imposed by law or policy.

2. Treasurer to the Board

The Chairperson of the Board appoints the Treasurer for the Board. This individual is responsible for making recommendations to the President and Board of Trustees regarding fiscal policy, directing and participating in the preparation of selected state and federal reports, presenting an annual budget to the President, Board of Trustees and college community, coordinating preparation for the annual financial audit of all District 510 accounts and student records, ensuring College funds are invested within the parameters of statutory requirements in a manner which provides the optimum yield and desired degree of liquidity, assessing College property tax needs and preparing tax levy requests for Board approval, representing the College in local, state and national professional organizations, attending all Board and Vice Presidents Council meetings as appropriate, and

assuming other duties and responsibilities as provided for in the Public Community College Act, and other laws of the State of Illinois.

3. Clerk to the Board

The Chairperson of the Board appoints the Clerk to the Board. This individual is responsible for notifying administrators before each Board meeting to submit items requested to be placed on the agenda, preparing draft copies of the agenda and Board packet for review by the College President and Secretary to the Board, scheduling an Agenda Prep meeting before each ensuing meeting to review items submitted with members of the President's Council, making necessary modifications to the agenda and Board packet at the direction of the President, scheduling meetings with the President, Chairperson of the Board and College Attorney to review information slated for Board action, and preparing, typing and transmitting the monthly meeting agenda and Board packet to the Trustees before each Board of Trustees meeting.

Other related duties as assigned include attending all Board of Trustees meetings, recording minutes and attendance of Board members present at the meeting, distributing Board packets and pertinent information, properly maintaining and storing all records and proceedings of the Board, and making travel arrangements and other accommodations for the Trustees when the need for travel is related to College business.
