This full-time accredited program prepares men and women to function effectively as entry level staff radiographers. The program includes both theoretical and practical courses as well as clinical education experiences in hospitals assigned by the program coordinator.

PROGRAM MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Radiologic Technology Program at South Suburban College is to provide a comprehensive education in order to prepare students to become entry-level radiographers. The program is designed to provide an environment that promotes stimulating intellectual discovery both didactically and clinically.

The Radiologic Technologies Program has specific admission requirements. Admission to the college does not guarantee acceptance into the Radiologic Technologies Program.



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Submit an Admissions Application and forward all high school as well as other college transcripts directly to the Office of Admissions and Registration.
2. Submit the Radiologic Technology Program Admission Application form to the Department by mail or in person at Room 4469L no later than March 1st prior to the Summer Semester wishing admission.
3. Admission to the Radiologic Technology Program will be determined by a ranking of the grade point average (GPA) of the program prerequisite courses only. No student will be considered for admission to the Radiologic Technology Program unless they have received at least a grade of "C" in all the program prerequisites and minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (A=4.00). Students must finish all prerequisite courses by December prior to the Summer Semester of the year you are seeking admission.
4. Applicants are notified in writing of their admission status no later than April 15.
5. Admission to the program will be determined by a ranking of the GPA based on the program prerequisite courses only.
